

DECLARATION OF CONFORMANCE

EUROPEAN DIRECTIVES - REGULATIONS – INGREDIENTS – INVENTORY LISTS

PERSPEX® XT extruded Acrylic sheets comply with the requirements of the European directives, regulations and other inventory lists as listed below.

The restricted or forbidden substances covered by the regulations are not used in the manufacturing process of the PMMA moulding compounds nor are they added to the manufacturing process of PERSPEX® XT Acrylic sheets.

Although we do not analyze our products for these substances we have no reason to expect that toxically substances or heavy metals, except of environmental traces, are present in our PERSPEX® XT Acrylic sheets which could induce hazard for health and environmental.

[e.g.: DDT, asbestos, formaldehyde, dioxin, furan, aromatic amines, triethanolamine, lead carbonates, lead sulfates, mercury, arsenic, cadmium, organo tin compounds, polychlorinated biphenyle, polychlorinated terphenyle, pentachlorophenol, vinyl chloride, aliphatic chlorinated hydrocarbons, tar oils, halogenated chlorinated hydrocarbons, silicones, azo-colours, ammonia compounds; colours, varnishes, pigments containing lead (Pb), cadmium, mercury or chromium(VI)] .

PERSPEX® XT Acrylic sheets do not contain BISPHENOL A.

PERSPEX® XT sheets conform to the REACH regulation. The sheets are made of toxicological harmless polymers and exempt from registration. They are insoluble in water. There is no obligation to label the resins as hazardous substances.

In case of fire and depending on the extent of oxygen transfer, products may decompose to carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide and water.

Manufacturing and Quality Control are carried out in accordance to the guidelines of the certified established quality management system in accordance with ISO 9001 and the product standard DIN EN ISO 7823-2.
