Declaration of Conformity to Directive 2011/65/UE

It is hereby DECLARED that the components of each and every one of our references of composite panel - **RedBOND Plus**, **RedBOND** and **RedBOND Life** - conforms **Directive 2011/65/CE**¹ of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

These restricted substances, in accordance with Annex II of this Directive, are not exceeding the limits as defined in the **RoHS Directive** and its maximum concentration values tolerated by weight are:

- Lead (Pb) (0,1 %)
- Mercury (Hg) (0,1 %)
- Cadmium (Cd) (0,01 %)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr+6) (0,1 %)

And the two types of polybrominated flame retardants:

- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0,1 %)
